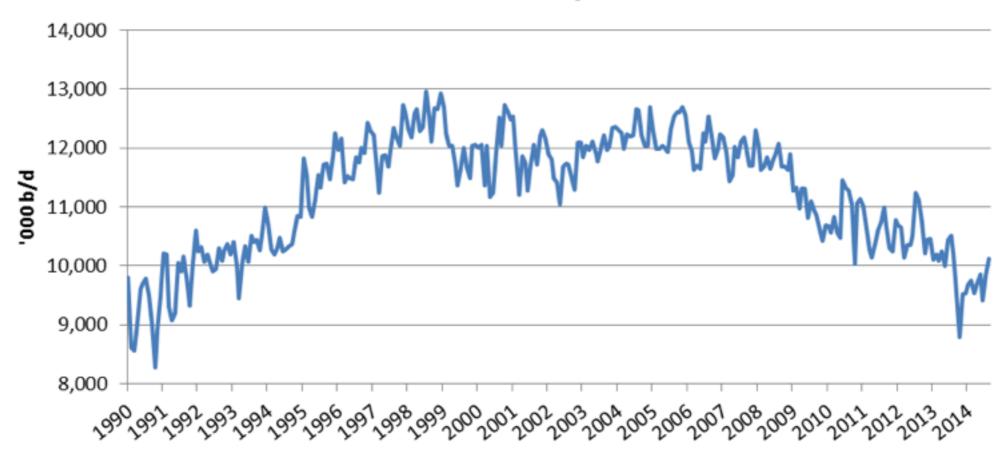

EU-16 refinery runs



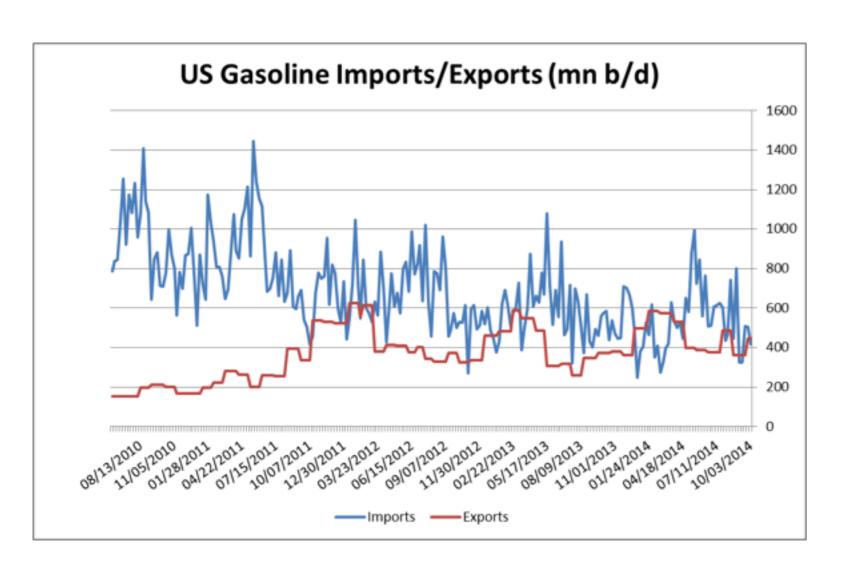
 ~ 10% of EU refining capacity closed since 2008 and more is at risk.

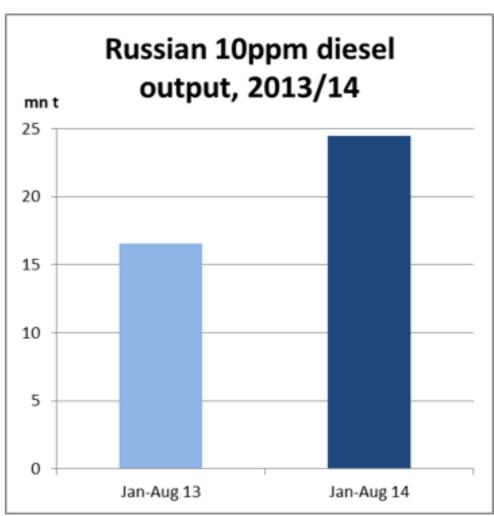




Europe refinery utilization only 83% Aug 2014 vs. US 95%.
